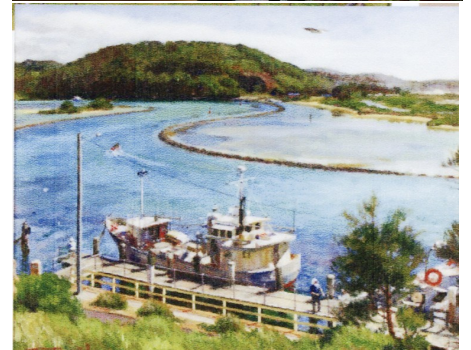
The Galleries are located at the Cottage between the Narooma Bowling club and Volume Plus Service Station, and also at Narooma Plaza on the top level.
